

## **PASSOVER FUNDS**

*Ma'ot Chitim*, which literally means “wheat money,” is an ancient custom designed to make sure that everyone has the means with which to celebrate and observe Passover. As we get closer to the Passover season, please make a special effort to bring foods that are marked Kosher for Passover to donate to the Rina Shkolnik Food Pantry.

If you have unopened *chametz* that you'd like to donate, bring that too. The Bridge Church supports the New York State Race Track Chaplaincy, and the food pantry at Our Lady of Lourdes Church can also use it.

While not required, it's customary to make a donation when selling one's *chametz*. Last year, the donations, which went into the Rabbi's Discretionary Fund, were divided up among these three organizations, which were most appreciative.
